

## Organ Transplant Awareness Program Organ Donation Scholarship Opportunity for High School Seniors!

This is an essay contest sponsored by Organ Transplant Awareness Program of New Mexico. This year there will be two \$500 scholarships awarded to New Mexico high school seniors. The awards are in memory of Betty Montoya, kidney recipient and Jaime Munoz, double lung recipient.

The purpose of the scholarship program is to promote organ and tissue donation as an important social responsibility while assisting New Mexico youth with higher education. Currently 800 New Mexicans await life-saving organ transplants. Unfortunately, many of these candidates will die before suitable organs and/or tissues become available. By increasing awareness of organ and tissue donation, we help people make informed decisions about registering to be an organ donor.

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- High school senior attending a public, private school or home school in New Mexico.
- Have a grade point average of 2.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.
- Intend to enroll in an accredited college, university, or vocational-technical school.

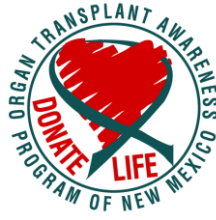
### TO APPLY FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP

1. Complete the attached application.
2. You may choose to write your essay on either of two topics:
  - a.) A Personal Story involving organ transplant or tissue donation.
  - b.) An Informative Essay on organ transplant or tissue donation.
3. All essays must be a **minimum** 2 full pages, 1" margins, double-spaced, 12 pt. Times Roman font, **plus** a title page with applicant's name, essay title and state either "Personal" or "Informative".

### SELECTION PROCESS

- An impartial selection committee will evaluate each application and essay. Upon review of all applications, the final committee will select the winning essays for awards.

Awards will be sent to the institution the student plans to attend upon verification of enrollment. The award may be utilized for school related expenses (tuition, fees or books). Recipients will need to provide photo identification, college student ID and address of college's financial aid office. Please feel free to make copies and distribute to teachers, counselors, and students. Also, please post in the teacher's lounge, counseling offices, and on websites.
